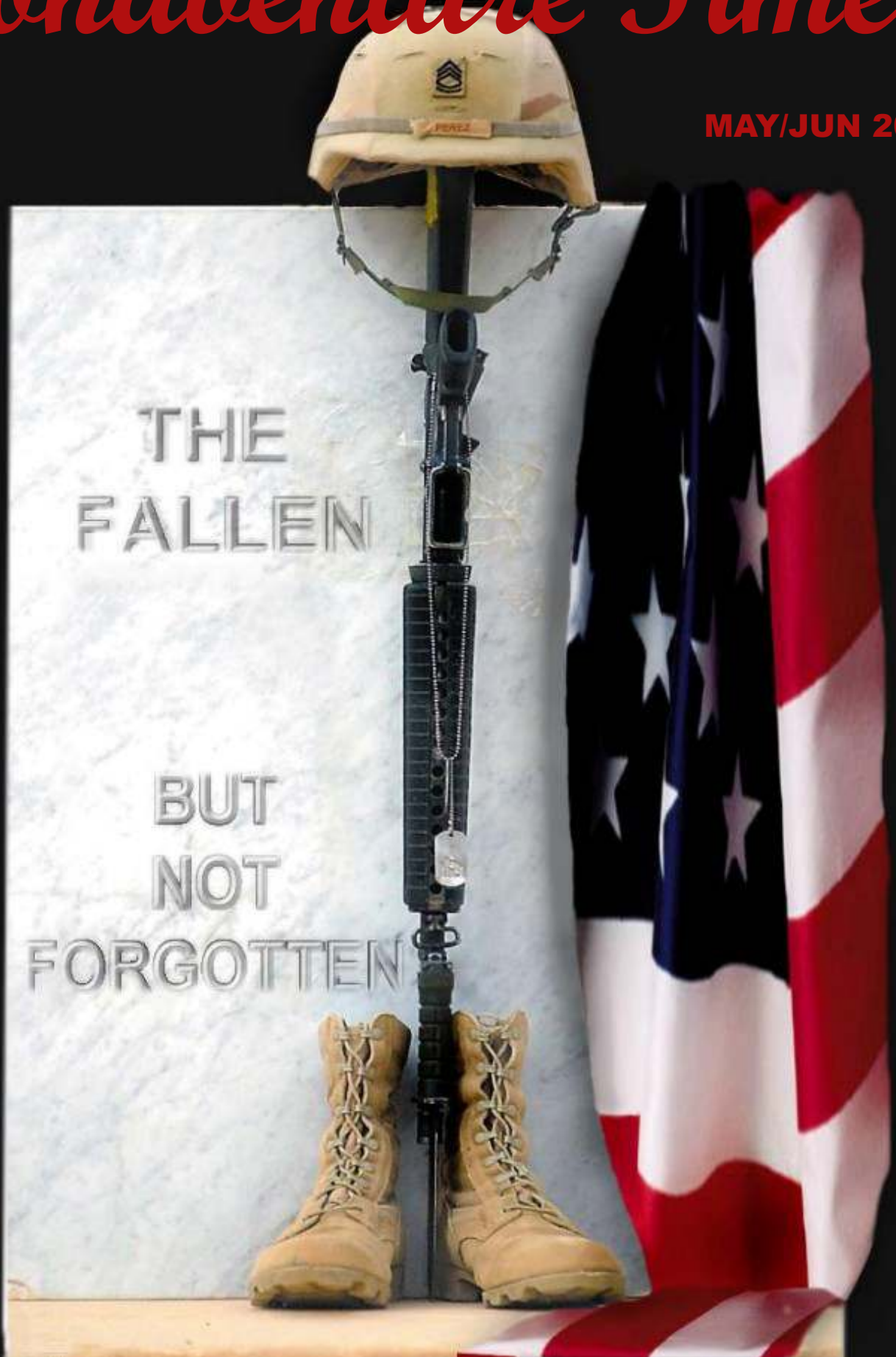

### HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE AND ELECTRONICS COLLECTION EVENT IN WESTON ON SUNDAY, MAY 20<sup>TH</sup>

On Sunday, May 20<sup>th</sup>, the drop off location is the **PUBLIC WORKS SERVICES CENTER**, between the hours of **8:00AM and 3:00 PM. The address is: 2599 South Post Road** (located on South Post Road between Manatee Isles Drive and Saddle Club Road).

**ITEMS ACCEPTED:** Oil and latex paints and thinners, used motor oil, auto fluids and gasoline solvents, pesticides, fertilizers, pool chemicals, drain cleaners, tires, mercury, rechargeable and automobile batteries; **Electronics:** such as computers, keyboards and televisions will be accepted.

### HURRICANE READINESS:

June 1<sup>st</sup> is usually the start of the Hurricane season in Florida. It is not too early to prepare emergency kits for your family and pets. **Recommended Supplies to include in a Basic Kit:** water, food, battery-powered radio & extra batteries, flashlight & extra batteries, first aid kit, whistle (to signal for help), moist towelettes, manual can opener, medicines, infant formula or diapers and important family documents.

**For pets:** besides food and water, medicines & medical records (if any), collar with ID tag, harness or leash, crate or other pet carrier, sanitation (litter box or paper towels & trash bags).

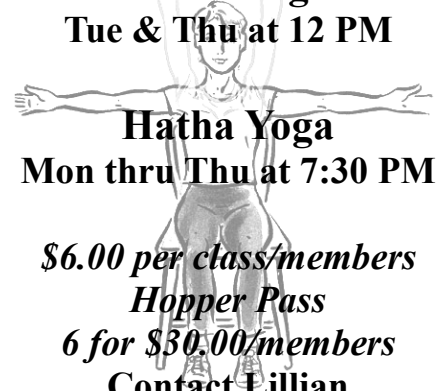
